- Reasonably clean, free of rust, food debris, stains, oils and excessive dirt
- No excessive scratches, dents, dings, watermarks, or other damage to item
- No defects, damage or repairs to the items structure or other parts that may deem the item unsafe
- Any mechanical or electric parts in good working order and should function as intended

## Monroe County Habitat for Humanity is also happy to announce that we are now able to accept some "like new/gently used" upholstered furniture for our upcoming ReStore!:

- No mattresses, pull-out beds, or futons
- No frays, tears, or otherwise damaged fabric
- No structural damage or excessive knicks, scratches etc. on wooden or metal parts
- No overly sagging cushion or lumpy fillings
- No pet stains, dander, fur etc.
- No odors
- Fabrics with patterns such as flowers, plaids etc. will be determined on a case-bycase situation. Due to limited store space, patterns that we have found to be typically hard to resell, may be turned down, even if it is otherwise in good condition.
